CONTRACT FOR PICKING TOMATOES.

This contract for picking tomatoes is entered into by Frank and John Joseph parties of the first part, and C.M.Gomez, party of the second part.

It is agreed that party of the second part shall pick all the 1927 crop of tomatoes now growing on the Schumann ranch known as San Vicente ranch situated on the McKeen Rd. It is agreed that the picking shall be done in a clean manner and that no rotten or unfit tomatoes shall be placed in the boxes. It is agreed tomatoes shall be placed in boxes by party of second part along waron roads made through the tomatoe field by party of first part.

It is agreed that as many pickings shall be made and at such times as party of first part shall design te. Also that party of the second part shall not harm tomatoes vines any more than is absolutely necessary in the picking operation.

It is agreed that parties of the first part shall pay party of the second part the sum of two dollars and sixty cents (\$2.60) per net ton of tomatoes upon completion of the picking job. However if part of the second part should desire small advances to pay men or buy food, then party of the first part may make such small advances at his pleasure.

It is agreed that a bonus of five cents (\$.05) shall be paid by
